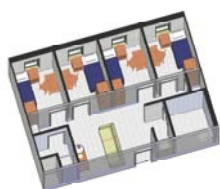
**A. Four Person Suite:**

\$4,535 per person



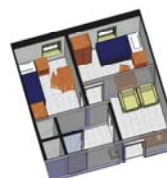
**C. Four Person Suite:**
