Financial Aid

We encourage you to sign up for financial aid early. If you have any questions regarding Financial Aid please visit <http://www.financialaid.wayne.edu/>. The cost to live in Ghafari or South Hall for one academic year is \$4,452. If you choose to live in the residence hall you must chose one of two mandatory meal plans that cost \$2,480 - \$2,740. The average cost of 24 credit hours for one academic year is \$6,496.60* (out-of-state \$13,497.40*). Please make sure that you apply for enough financial aid to cover your room, board and tuition at Wayne State University.

*These figures reflect the current 2007/2008 rates only and not the 2008/2009 rates and are therefore subject to be increased for the 2008/2009 school year.

- Applications received after June 27, 2008, that are later cancelled will forfeit the \$100 security deposit.
